

1. TYPES OF URBAN GOVERNMENT IN INDIA.

Municipal Corporations are created for the administration of large cities like Delhi and Mumbai. They are established in the state by the acts of the states concerned and in the UTs by the acts of the Parliament. A MC is composed of three authorities such as the council, the standing committees and the commissioner. The council is headed by a Mayor. The Municipal commissioner is chief executive of the corporation responsible for implementation of decisions taken by the council.

Municipalities are established for administration of smaller towns and smaller cities. The council is headed by the President or chairman.
