

## 1. DISCUSS THE PRIVILEGES AND IMMUNITIES ENJOYED BY THE GOVERNOR OF A STATE IN INDIA.

The Governor is the de jure head of the state. He enjoys certain privileges and immunities like the President of India. He enjoys personal immunity from legal liability for his official acts. During his term of office, he is immune from any criminal proceedings, even in respect of his personal acts. He cannot be arrested or imprisoned. However, civil proceedings can be initiated against him by giving two months' notice.
