

1. GIVE A BRIEF ACCOUNT OF THE BASIC STRUCTURE OF THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

The Constitution of India does not explain the term 'basic structure'. However, the SC in its judgement on Keshavananda Bharti case evolved the concept of 'basic structure'. According to it, every provision of the Constitution can amended without affecting or diluting the basic structure of the constitution. From time to time the SC has included various features of the Constitution under the definition of Basic Structure. Some of the basic features are supremacy of the constitution, fundamental rights, judicial review, rule of law, secular character of the constitution, unity and integrity of the country etc.
